- 1. The plaintiff seeks compliance by the defendant no.7 of the order dated 8th April, 2016 by deposit of the requisite royalty before this Court in case the defendant no.7 intends to communicate to the public any of the plaintiff's repertoire of songs comprising of performance of any of its members during the matches in the onging IPL season.
