Issue notice to the respondents on payment of process fee by registered as well as ordinary mode. Process fee be paid during the course of the day.

The State Counsel appearing for respondents No.1, 2, 3 and 5 is directed to file its return.

The counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply an advance notice to Shri Deepak Khot who is Standing Counsel for the Municipal Corporation, Gwalior.

The counsel for the petitioner is also directed to supply an advance notice to Shri Nakul Khedkar who is also directed to seek instructions in the matter and to file its return by the next date of hearing.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that feature film "Sonchiraia" has been released which is based on the life of the present petitioner but same has been made without seeking permission and knowledge of the petitioner.

It is further submitted that from the trailers, it appears that even otherwise wrong picturization has been done.

Accordingly, the respondents No.7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 are directed to bring the original DVD of the film so that the joint screening of the petitioner as well as the respondents can be organized, if occasion arises.

Heard on I.A.No.947/2019 which is an application for substituted service of respondents No.6 to 14 and 16.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. The petitioner is permitted to serve the respondents No.6 to 14 and 16 by substituted service.

It is directed that on payment of process fee during the course of day by registered as well as ordinary mode and also for sending the notices by fax/Electronic Mail Service as provided under Order V Rule 21 of CPC, the notices be issued to the respondents No.6 to 14 and 16.
