1. Heard Shri Venkatesh Dhond, the Learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the Plaintiffs.

The Plaintiffs have filed the present suit restraining the Defendants known and unknown from infringing in any way the copyright of the Plaintiff in the film known as "The Hobbit-An Unexpected Journey" through different mediums like CD, DVD, Blu-ray, VCD, Cable TV, DTH, Internet, MMS, Tapes, Conditional Access System or in any other like manner.
3. I have perused the orders passed by the various High Courts and this Court granting injunction on similar lines so as to protect copyright.

4. In that view of the matter, issue notice returnable in four weeks. Until further orders, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clauses (b) and (e).

5. The Plaintiffs are entitled to communicate Mr. John Doe in local newspapers in all the states where it has apprehension of infringement of copyrights.
