

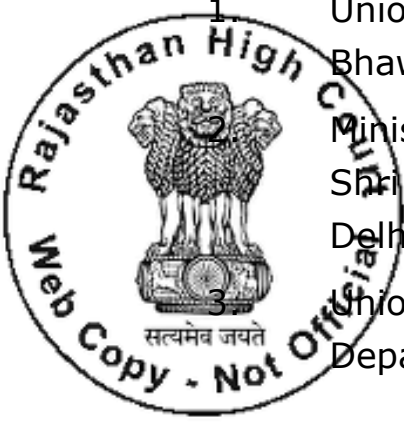

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

In this writ petition, the petitioner has filed the present writ
petition under the label of Public Interest Litigation, seeking
following relief(s):

*"In the above facts and circumstances, the petitioner most
respectfully prays to this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue
the following directions tot he State Government: -*

*(a) By issuing appropriate order/writ the Advisory
No.40011/01/2014-bc-1 (ANNEXURE-3) issued by the ministry of*

information & broadcasting for constraining telecast of condom advertisements between 10.00 pm – 06.00 am may kindly be quashed in the interest of public and grounds mentioned in supra para.

(b) By issuing appropriate order/writ the Respondents be directed to delete the following line "Any failure will attract action as per provisions of the Rules", from the advisory.

(c) That the appropriate directions may be issued for preparing suitable guidelines for advertising condoms.

(d) That any order this Hon'ble Court deems it fit to pass."



Admittedly, some Rules are framed by the respondent State Government to regulate the advertisement of condoms, in our opinion it is the duty of the legislature to regulate such telecast of advertisement of condoms, therefore, no interference is called for in this petition.

The writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
