1. The petitioner is seeking stay of the release of the movie 'Bharat' on the ground that the movie portrays the country in a disrespectful manner.
2. The petitioner present in person admits that he has not seen the movie and has based his opinion only on the basis of the trailer of 3 minutes. In that view of the matter, the petition is pre-mature.
3. The petitioner has produced his mobile which contains trailer. This Court does not find merit in the averments of the petitioner on the basis of the trailer.
4. Learned senior counsel for respondents No.4 to 7 submits that the petitioner has widely publicised the filing of this case in the social media.

The copy of the email of the petitioner on the media website is handed over and taken on record. The email reflects the petitioner is publicity hungry.

5. The petition is dismissed.
